
Dyr Vision

State & Local Resource Alignment

Strengthen partnerships between IRRC and 2-1-1 to improve access to services for agencies and New Americans.

Health Care Eligibility Guide

Collaborate with the Office of Global Michigan to create a quick-reference guide for healthcare eligibility.

Maximize collaboration and focus efforts on key challenges to integration and inclusion



Priority 3: Advocacy

Empower nontraditional partners to assist New Americans in meeting their needs and celebrating their cultures

Financial Literacy Access

Support and promote financial literacy classes tailored to newcomers beyond the resettlement period.

Legal Services Expansion

Broaden access to legal services for New Americans.

Community Events & Advocacy

Celebrate New Americans by facilitating access to naturalization information, organize cultural briefings, and hosting events to celebrate the region's diverse heritage.

Ensure New Americans guide the collaborative, and the IRRC responds to their needs

Faith & Community Collaboration

Partner with communities to raise awareness of local resources.

Welcoming

Enhance collaborative efforts through book discussions and cultural events.


Culturally Sensitive Outreach

Provide cultural advising and assist agencies with outreach and program challenges.


